1. ORACLE E-PERFORMANCE & E-COMPENSATION MODULES (PEPPM)

The Central Susquehanna Intermediate Unit (CSIU) awarded a contract covering Oracle Database Management Systems, and PRT wishes to make purchases under the terms and conditions of this 2023 PEPPM Contract.

The Contract is effective through December 31, 2023, and PRT wishes to purchase the Oracle e-Performance and e-Compensation software application modules that are needed within the Human Resources Department to better manage the day-to-day operations.
