

<u>FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE</u> (July 21, 2023) – Pittsburgh Regional Transit will host two public meetings next month on possible public transit and pedestrian improvements along the PA-837 corridor between Homestead and McKeesport.

PRT employees and consultants will present existing conditions and conceptual designs for potential changes to the corridor. The first round of public meetings were held in December 2021.
