

PRT Thanksgiving Service

<u>FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE</u> (November 21, 2023) – Pittsburgh Regional Transit will operate modified service on Thursday, November 23, for Thanksgiving.

Buses will operate on Sunday schedules; however, some detours will be in effect for 33 routes from 7 a.m. to approximately noon to accommodate the YMCA Turkey Trot. For a full listing of the various detours, visit https://www.rideprt.org/Detours/.

Red and Silver Line rail service will run every 40 minutes on a Thanksgiving schedule that can be found at www.rideprt.org/holidays. The Blue Line will not be in operation.

Riders are encouraged to check schedules before heading out.

PRT's administrative offices and the Downtown Service Center will be closed. Customer Service representatives will be available 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
