

## **PRT Service for Juneteenth National Freedom Day**

<u>FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE</u> (June 16, 2025) – Pittsburgh Regional Transit bus and light-rail service will operate regular weekday schedules on Thursday, June 19 during Juneteenth National Freedom Day.

Customer Service representatives will be available by phone from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. and via live chat from 5 a.m. to 8 p.m. The Downtown Service Center and administrative offices will be closed in observance of the holiday.

On Saturday, June 21, riders are encouraged to allow for additional travel time as the Grand Jubilee Parade is expected to create delays and detours in downtown Pittsburgh. Additional Juneteenth celebrations will take place at Mellon Park June 19-22, and riders are encouraged to allow for additional travel time those days.
