**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE** (June 11, 2021) – Port Authority of Allegheny County plans to reopen the Silver Line – Library for regular service on Monday, June 14.

The light rail line has been closed since June 5 while crews replaced utility poles and overhead wiring.
