

Broken Rail Along Warrington Avenue Disrupts Light-Rail Service

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (December 16, 2025) - A broken rail on the outbound track along Warrington Avenue has disrupted Pittsburgh Regional Transit's light-rail service and requires immediate repair.

The amount of time needed to repair the rail is currently unknown.

To support riders during the disruption, PRT is operating bus shuttles between Station Square and South Hills Junction. Light-rail service will continue to operate between Station Square and Allegheny Station. PRT route foremen are on-site at Station Square and South Hills Junction to assist passengers.
