



PRT Announces Light Up Night Service

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (November 20, 2025) – Pittsburgh Regional Transit will detour 50 bus routes in Downtown Pittsburgh on Saturday for the city’s annual Light Up Night festivities.

Fourteen routes – **8-Perrysville, 13-Bellevue, 16-Brighton, 17-Shadeland, 20-Kennedy, 21-Coraopolis, 22-McCoy, 24- West Park, 26-Chartiers, 27-Fairywood, 29-Robinson, 31, Bridgeville, 36, Banksville, and 38-Green Tree** – will be detoured from the start of service on Saturday, November 22, while crews set up for the event on Stanwix Street and Fort Duquesne Boulevard.

These routes, along with an additional 36 routes – **1-Freeport Road 2-Mt. Royal, 4-Troy Hill, 6-Spring Hill, 11-Fineview, 12-McKnight, 15-Charles, 39-Brookline, 40-Mt. Washington, 41-Bower Hill, 43-Bailey, 44-Knoxville, 48-Arlington, 51-Carrick, 56-Lincoln Place, 57-Hazelwood, 58-Greenfield, 67-Monroeville, 77-Penn Hills, 81-Oak Hill, 82-Lincoln, 83-Bedford Hill, 86-Liberty, 87-Friendship, 88-Penn, 91-Butler Street, G2-West Busway, P1-East Busway, 28X-Airport Flyer, 61A-North Braddock, 61B-Swissvale, 61C-McKeesport-Homestead, 71B-Highland Park, Y46-Elizabeth Flyer, Y47 Curry Flyer, and Y49-Prospect Flyer** – will be detoured from 4 p.m. on Saturday, November 22, through the end of service.

Some routes will end on the East Busway after 4 p.m.; riders can transfer for free at Penn Station to continue their trip.

Beginning at 4 p.m. on Saturday, all outbound routes from Downtown will operate entirely or partially within the Smithfield Street bus lane for the remainder of the evening. **The primary boarding point for all detoured buses will be the stop at Smithfield Street and Sixth Avenue**, with additional stops provided as routing allows.

Riders should be aware that after 4 p.m., no bus service will be available on any Downtown streets north of Smithfield Street, including Stanwix Street, Wood Street, and Liberty Avenue.

Regular service will resume with the first scheduled trips on Sunday, November 23.

PRT does not anticipate that the Monongahela Incline will reopen this weekend. Shuttle vans will continue to operate between Station Square and the upper incline station every 15-20 minutes.
