## **PROPOSED RESOLUTION**

## **AWARDING OF BIDS**

### **1. Omnissa Horizon 8 Licensing**

Solicitation B25-27 was publicly advertised and ebusiness documents were distributed. A total of 880 suppliers were notified of the bid opportunity, 11 suppliers accepted the invitation, and 10 bids were received to provide Omnissa Horizon 8 Licensing, which is a Virtual Desktop Infrastructure (VDI) allowing access to virtual desktops from nearly any device utilized by the Technology Infrastructure Division over a three period, with no renewal options available.

One bidder was found to be non-responsive in accordance with the specifications as advertised.

- a) In accordance with Section 3(e), Bidder Requirements: "While Bidders may offer pricing reflected on other government contracts, the Terms and Conditions of those contracts will not be considered applicable to this bid or any resultant contract and only the CIBs within this solicitation will apply hereto. Any attempt to alter the precedence of the CIBs, including the indemnification or warranty provisions therein either through bidder's bid submission or through any User Agreement provided pursuant to Section 3.4 herein or otherwise will render bidder's bid submission non-responsive and ineligible for award." The bidder included language noting that their terms supersede the terms of the solicitation.

**RECOMMENDATION:** That a contract be awarded to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder, Saitech Inc., in the estimated amount of \$320,498.50.

There has been no previous purchase of this service as it was previously purchased with other software and services. Staff has determined the pricing to be fair and reasonable and consistent with the funds budgeted.

## **RESOLUTION**
