Service Changes Begin February 22

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (January 22, 2026) – Minor service changes are in store for riders when Pittsburgh Regional Transit implements its tri-annual schedule adjustments late next month.

With regular service changes on February 22, 2026, several routing changes will be made, including:

- PRT removed the contraflow bus lane on Fifth Avenue in Oakland in January to allow contractors to build a new bi-directional bike lane on Fifth Avenue as part of PRT's University Line bus rapid transit project, and the nine bus routes that traveled outbound in the bus lane on Fifth Avenue shifted over to Forbes Avenue.

The new routing will now be built into the schedules for the 54-North Side-Oakland-South Side, 61D-Murray Short, 71A-Negley Short, 71B-Highland Park, 71C-Point Breeze Short, 71D-Hamilton Short, 75-Ellsworth, 93-Lawrenceville-Hazelwood, and P3-East Busway-Oakland.

- Routing has changed for the 55-Glassport, and some stops will not be served due to construction of the Mon Fayette Expressway.

Some routes will also experience minor trip time adjustments and frequency updates.

Service via the 54-North Side-Oakland-South Side over the Herron Avenue Bridge and to The Waterfront in Homestead via the 53-Homestead Park, 53L-Homestead Park Limited, 57-Hazelwood, 59-Mon Valley, 61D-Murray, and 64-Lawrenceville-Waterfront will not change, but schedules will be made permanent. These routes were previously on detour.
