1. Approval of Minutes

The minutes of the March 20, 2025, Planning & Stakeholder Relations Committee were approved.

2. Update on NEXTransit Downtown Infrastructure Plans (Amy Silbermann)

The NEXTransit Downtown project was designed to update downtown bus routing including the PRTX University Line.

Beginning in 2023, these service routing have been slowly implemented over the last 5-6 service changes. Ahead of the June University Line changes, some infrastructure will be implemented.

Bus Infrastructure

- Six modular curb extensions (bus platforms) are to be installed adjacent to the sidewalk
- These will provide more space for waiting riders at larger volume stops or in areas with small sidewalks
- There will also be some changes to signage and pavement markings to support these platforms and some bus turning movements

Bus Platforms

- Forbes Avenue at Grant Street
- Wood Street at Forbes Avenue
- Stanwix Street past Penn Avenue
- Fort Duquesne Boulevard at 6th Street

- 7th Street past Penn Avenue
- Wood Street at Sixth Avenue

Bus Routes Changing in Downtown (June 2025)

- The University Line Bus Rapid Transit bus routes **61A, 61B, 61C, 71B**
- South Hills Commuter Routes **51L, Y1, Y45**
- East Busway Express Routes **P7, P17, P69, P76, P78**
- Hill District Routes **81, 82, 83**
- East Busway and West Busway core routes **P1, G2**
