

## Construction to Affect Fifth Avenue at Market Square

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE** (October 15, 2025) – Construction to repair a drainage issue adjacent to the Market Square PRTX station in downtown Pittsburgh will begin on Monday, October 20, Pittsburgh Regional Transit announced today.

Market Street between Fifth Avenue and Liberty Avenue and Fifth Avenue between Market Street and Liberty Avenue will be closed for approximately three weeks while PRT contractors make repairs to a drainage issue that is causing water to collect at the corner of Fifth Avenue and Market Street.

Construction work will occur from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

During construction, the bus-only/right turning lane from Market Street to Liberty Avenue will be closed. Buses will continue to travel inbound toward Liberty Avenue by operating in the oncoming traffic lane. Bus routes 61A, 61B, 61C, 71B, G2, and P1 will not serve the Market Street PRTX station. Riders should use the existing bus stop on Liberty Avenue at Market Street.

Vehicles will be unable to turn right from Liberty Avenue onto Fifth Avenue during construction.

Market Street between Liberty and Fifth avenues will be closed for parking and vehicular traffic.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.
