

State funding has failed to keep up with the costs of operating public transit, creating a funding crisis for Pittsburgh Regional Transit (PRT) and transit agencies across Pennsylvania.

PRT is currently projecting a \$100 million shortfall for its next fiscal year. Absent new funding, PRT would be forced to narrow the funding gap by cutting service and increasing fares starting in 2026.

PRT will also have to raise the cost of transit fares. A base 3-hour fare would increase from \$2.75 to \$3.00 a day pass would increase from \$7 to \$7.50, a 7-day pass would increase from \$25 to 27.00, a 31-day pass would increase from \$97.50 to \$106.50, and an annual pass would increase from \$1,072.50 to \$1,171.50 The questions that follow will allow you to share your feelings with PRT about these changes.

## ACCESS service reductions and fare increases Service Reductions

PRT will enforce the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) service area for eligible individuals. Proposed reductions in fixed route bus service takes some areas out of the ADA service area that is eligible for ACCESS and puts them into an area where service for people with disabilities could have trip denials and where reservations would not be guaranteed. This would result in a reduction in the ADA service area of 62%, 16% of which is due to the change in fixed route services. Service would not be available after 11 p.m. all days of the week.
