



Weekend Detours for Veterans Day Parade and EQT Pittsburgh Races

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (November 6, 2025) – Several bus routes will be detoured in and around the downtown Pittsburgh area this weekend to accommodate the annual Veterans Day Parade and the EQT Pittsburgh 10 Miler and 10K.

On Saturday, November 8, the city's 106th annual Veterans Day Parade will close several streets downtown. The parade will start at the intersection of Tenth Street and Liberty Avenue, and proceed down Liberty Avenue toward Point State Park. Bus detours will begin around 9 a.m. and continue until approximately 2:30 p.m.

On Sunday, more than 40 routes will be impacted by the EQT Pittsburgh 10 Miler and 10K, which will start at Station Square and the North Shore, respectively. The course goes through the West End, North Shore, Strip District, and downtown. About a dozen bus routes will begin detouring at the start of regular service, with additional detours beginning around 6:30 a.m. Streets are expected to reopen by 1 p.m.

Complete detour details for both events will be available at www.rideprt.org/detours. Riders are encouraged to check detour information before traveling and allow extra time for their trips.

Additionally, PRT buses and rail will operate regular weekday service on Tuesday, November 11 for Veterans Day. PRT's administrative offices and Downtown Service Center will be closed for the holiday.
