**Your fare will get you farther.** Instead of \$2.75 per trip with a ConnectCard, transfers have been eliminated and your fare will include **FREE** transfers for up to three hours.

### SPECIAL FARES

**Children ages 6-11** pay half the full ConnectCard fare with a Kid's ConnectCard. Cash half fare is **\$1.35**.

**Children 5** and under ride **FREE** when accompanied by a fare-paying adult.

**Individuals with disabilities** pay half the full ConnectCard fare with a Pittsburgh Regional Transit Reduced Fare ConnectCard. Cash half fare is **\$1.35**.

**Seniors** ride **FREE** with a Pittsburgh Regional Transit Senior Citizen ConnectCard or when displaying a state-issued senior citizen transit pass.

The City of Pittsburgh and PRT celebrate the annual Richard S. Caliguiri 5K and 10K Great Race!

The **5K race** will begin in Oakland on Fifth Avenue at Atwood Street at 8 a.m. and proceed to downtown Pittsburgh along Fifth Avenue and The Boulevard of the Allies. PRT will provide service between Downtown and Oakland during the race via a special bus route designated "**5K Richard S. Caliguiri Great Race.**"

The **10K race** will begin in Squirrel Hill at Frick Park on Beechwood Boulevard at 9:30 a.m. and proceed to Downtown along Forbes, Morewood and Fifth avenues and The Boulevard of the Allies. PRT will provide service between Downtown and Squirrel Hill during the race via a special bus route designated "**10K Richard S. Caliguiri Great Race.**"

The 5K and 10K buses will operate via the East Busway between downtown Pittsburgh, Oakland and Squirrel Hill since many local roads will be closed to traffic.

**During this event, hundreds of bus stops in downtown Pittsburgh, Uptown, Squirrel Hill, and Oakland will be temporarily discontinued and dozens of bus routes will be on extensive detours.**

**Due to the scale of service disruptions during the Great Race, riders are urged to allow additional travel time to get to their destinations.**

**Regular fares will apply.**

### **Service between downtown Pittsburgh & Oakland**

5K will start service from Downtown at 6 a.m. and will depart approximately every 10 minutes until the beginning of the race at 8 a.m. After the race begins, buses will depart downtown approximately every 15 minutes until regular service resumes around noon.

5K will start service from Oakland at 6:30 a.m. and will depart approximately every 10 minutes until the beginning of the race at 8 a.m. After the race begins, buses will depart Oakland approximately every 15 minutes until regular service resumes around noon.

**Return service (and its frequency) is conditional based upon the availability of street access due to event-related closures.**

5K will only serve the following bus stops between 6 a.m. and noon:

#### **From Downtown to Oakland**

Board on Stanwix Street at Penn Avenue (Gateway #2).

#### **From Oakland to Downtown**

Board on Bigelow Boulevard at Fifth Avenue

### **Service between downtown Pittsburgh & Squirrel Hill**

10K will start service from Downtown at 7 a.m. and will depart approximately every 10 minutes until the beginning of the race at 9:30 a.m. After the race begins, buses will depart downtown approximately every 15 minutes until regular service resumes around noon.

10K will start service from Squirrel Hill at 7:30 a.m. and will depart approximately every 10 minutes until the beginning of the race at 9:30 a.m. After the race begins, buses will depart Squirrel Hill every 15 minutes until regular service resumes around noon.

**Return service (and its frequency) is conditional based upon the availability of street access due to event-related closures.**

10K will only serve the following bus stops between 7 a.m. and noon:

#### **From Downtown to Squirrel Hill**

Board on Stanwix Street at Penn Avenue (Gateway #2).

#### **From Squirrel Hill to Downtown**

Board on Forbes Avenue past Beechwood Boulevard
