



NEXT ROUND OF SERVICE CHANGES GO INTO EFFECT NOVEMBER 24

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (October 31, 2019) - Port Authority is making getting to and from Pittsburgh International Airport easier with a new drop-off location for the 28X-Airport Flyer at the commercial departures curb of the landside terminal.

The change will occur with the next round of schedule adjustments on Sunday, November 24.

The 28X will continue to pick passengers up commercial arrivals curb at Door 6 of the landside terminal.

“Much like we at Port Authority connect our communities to the region, Pittsburgh International Airport connects our region to the world,” said Port Authority CEO Katharine Kelleman. “So whether you’re heading to Carnegie, Clearwater or Croatia, this change will make getting there and coming home easier.”

Also beginning on November 24, the P16-Penn Hills Flyer, which had been detoured due to a local construction project, will return to Hulton Road to serve Hulton Arbors, Oakmont and Harmar.

Lastly, the P10-Allegheny Flyer will no longer serve RIDC Park in O’Hara. A new variant, the P10-Allegheny Flyer Limited, will serve RIDC Park with additional weekday trips.
