PRT Service for Juneteenth National Freedom Day

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (June 14, 2024) – Pittsburgh Regional Transit bus and light-rail service will operate on regular weekday schedules on Wednesday, June 19 in observance of Juneteenth National Freedom Day.

Customer Service representatives will be available to assist riders from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. PRT's administrative offices and Downtown Service Center will be closed.

On Saturday, June 15, riders are encouraged to allow for additional travel time as more than 30 bus routes will be detoured from about 9:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. for events related to the holiday. A complete list of detoured routes is available at www.portauthority.org/detours/.

Riders are additionally reminded that PRT will be closing the Red Line starting Sunday, June 16 through the end of August and that schedules for more than 30 bus routes will also be adjusted that day. More information can be found at www.ridePRT.org/ServiceUpdates.
