



Next Service Adjustments Start October 20

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (September 20, 2024) – Additional trips and new downtown routing on a handful of bus routes highlight Pittsburgh Regional Transit’s service adjustments going into effect next month.

Trips will be added to the 54-North Side-Oakland-South Side, 71A-Negley, 71C-Point Breeze, 75-Ellsworth, and P78-Oakmont Flyer starting October 20. The additional trips are expected to improve service reliability, on-time performance, and address crowding issues.

The 7-Spring Garden, 19L-Emsworth Limited, P12-Holiday Park Flyer, P16-Penn Hills Flyer, P67-Monroeville Flyer will have new routing in downtown Pittsburgh to streamline operations and improve connections for riders.

Additional changes going into effect on October 20 include:

- The G2-West Busway is being extended to Penn Station on the East Busway because of a long-term detour.
- The 29-Robinson will terminate at CCAC West due to the closure of Pittsburgh Technical College.
- A temporary rail route called the “Subway Local” will operate between Allegheny Station and South Hills Junction to support upcoming rail projects.
