Monongahela Incline to be Closed for Three Days

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (November 4, 2024) – The Monongahela Incline will be closed for three days this week for scheduled maintenance.

Crews will shut down the incline from Wednesday, November 6 through Friday, November 8 to replace the safety cable.

The safety cable is replaced every six to eight years based on testing results. The work is not related to the recently completed rehabilitation project.

Riders traveling to and from Mt. Washington are encouraged to use the 40-Mt. Washington or shuttle buses, which will operate between the bus stop adjacent to Station Square Station and the upper incline station.
