***Silver Line Service Partially Restored***

*Repairs to the Remainder of the Line Will Continue into Next Week*

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (November 15, 2024)** - Pittsburgh Regional Transit has partially restored service on the Silver Line - Library, three days after an electrical issue forced the agency to close the line to conduct emergency repairs.

The Silver Line is now open to Lytle Station. The line is expected to remain closed from Lytle to Library Station through next week, with shuttle buses operating between those stations via Route 88/Library Road.

PRT closed the Silver Line on Wednesday morning after an electrical cable failed.
