



## **Service Adjustments Coming February 2025**

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE** (January 24, 2025) – Detours related to the closure of the Mt. Washington Transit Tunnel are among the key changes in the service adjustments scheduled for February 23, 2025.

The Mt. Washington Transit Tunnel will be closed for approximately eight months to allow critical repairs to the tracks, roadway, and overhead electric lines inside the tunnel.

### **Rail Service Adjustments**

*Red and Blue Lines:* Weekday light-rail service will detour via the tracks along Warrington and Arlington avenues in Allentown.

*Silver Line:* On weekdays, service will operate between Library Station and Washington Junction to minimize congestion in Allentown. Riders can transfer to Red and Blue line light-rail cars at Washington Junction.

*Weekend Rail Service:* Red, Blue, and Silver Lines will operate via Allentown on weekends.

*Temporary “Subway Local”:* PRT will introduce a temporary rail route connecting Station Square to Allegheny Station during the tunnel closure.

**Station Square will be included in the Free Fare Zone from February 23 until the project is complete.**

### **Bus Service Adjustments**

Some bus routes will also be detoured due to the closure of the Mt. Washington Transit Tunnel project. For detailed detour information, visit [www.ridePRT.org/mtwashrailreplace](http://www.ridePRT.org/mtwashrailreplace).

Additional Service Changes:

- **28X-Airport Flyer:** During off-peak hours, the 28X will run every 40 minutes during off-peak hours and every 30 to 33 minutes during peak, midday, and evening hours.
- **69-Trafford:** The last weekday Downtown trip will end at midnight. The last inbound trip to Wilkesburg Station will end 1:11 a.m.
- **74-Homewood-Squirrel Hill** and **89-Garfield Commons:** Inbound trips will be rerouted via Highland Avenue-Baum Boulevard-Beatty Street.
- **75-Ellsworth:** The last Saturday outbound trip will end in Morningside instead of East Liberty Station.
- **P12-Holiday Park Flyer:** The weekday Beacon Hill variants will be eliminated due to low ridership; routes will use South and Rebecca avenues in Wilkesburg.
- **P68-Braddock Hills Flyer:** Trips will now begin and end at Forbes Hospital, with weekday frequency adjusted to every 31 minutes during peak hours and every 62 minutes during off-peak hours.
- **P78-Oakmont Flyer:** Weekday service to Harmar Park and Ride will be discontinued. An additional outbound trip departing Downtown at 6:43 a.m. will be added to improve schedule efficiency.
