The City of Pittsburgh has provided permits to Pittsburgh Three Rivers Marathon (P3R), Incorporated to hold various and multiple marathon events over the weekend of April 29 - May 1, 2022 and to close, open and change street closure locations for set-up, actual marathon routings and dismantling of materials after each event.

The second major Pittsburgh Marathon event requiring a detour will be the Chick-fil-A Pittsburgh 1 Mile Kid's Marathon on Saturday, April 30, 2022.

The Children's Marathon will begin on the North Side on West General Robinson Street, between Chuck Noll Way and Mazeroski Way, using only West General Robinson and Sandusky Street towards Downtown Pittsburgh, crossing the Seventh Street Bridge, then via Seventh Street, Sixth Avenue and Wood Street to the finish line on the Boulevard of the Allies at Stanwix Street.

Due to the slightly different course, certain select North Side routes can resume all or a portion of their North Side routings on around Allegheny Commons.

Their Downtown detour will remain the same as it was for the 5K run.

All streets noted and at least a one block area including all intersecting streets to the above will be closed.

Limited street re-openings in the North Side are anticipated to begin around 10:00 AM.

The Chick-fil-A Pittsburgh 1 Mile Kid's Marathon will start at 10:30 AM, to conclude on the Boulevard of the Allies at Stanwix Street around 12:30 PM.

ALL routes following the UPMC 5K Run Detour from earlier Saturday morning (Detour #22-101-0) EXCEPT those noted here (Routes 13, 16 & 54) will continue to follow that same detour until ALL Saturday events have been completed.

All street closures (except for the finish line, which will remain closed for the remainder of Saturday) should be re-opened for Saturday by 12:30 PM.
